NEC after the NICU

Your baby can thrive after NEC. Sometimes, babies do not have any long-term complications when they go home after a NEC diagnosis. Othertimes, babies experience mild to severe lifealtering complications after they have been home from the NICU for weeks, months, or even years.

Every baby is unique, and it can be hard to know if your baby will experience long-term complications from NEC. If possible, continue to provide your baby with your breastmilk or donor milk.

Your baby may need many follow-up appointments to help them thrive at home. Every appointment helps your baby receive the care they need. You may see many different specialists at these appointments. Write things down, ask questions, and find someone to support you to help you navigate your child's healthcare needs after the NICU.

After a NEC diagnosis, some babies may have difficulty reaching developmental milestones during their first months and years of life. Potential complications from NEC can increase the risk of infections and the need for future hospitalizations.

Potential complications after NEC:

- Gastrointestinal (digestive) problems
- Slow growth
- Cognitive delays
- **Bowel surgery**
